NEW MEDICATION PROCEDURE –

This summer we will be utilizing **Camp Meds** for medication distribution for campers who require medication over the summer.

Camper medical forms as well as information on this new system will be coming to you in the mail.

If your camper requires medication over the summer, **go to** www.campmeds.com for details on how to **register for this service**.

Camp Meds will fill the medications and package them by dosage and then deliver them directly to camp to be distributed to your camper by our nursing staff.

This system is designed for camps to make distribution of meds easier and faster thereby allowing campers to get back to camp activities more quickly.

Please be on the lookout for the mailer with all of the Medical Information.

BEFORE YOU PACK...

NAME TAPES must be sewn in or ironed on all clothing.

If marking your child's clothing with a **permanent marker** (ie: Sharpie), please write:

- **FIRST** and **LAST** name of your child to make identification clearer if clothing is misplaced.
- **DO NOT USE INITIALS** as campers may have the same initials as other campers.
- **REMEMBER to label shoes, sneakers, sports equipment, hair brushes, and toiletries.**

TRUNK PICK-UP – You will receive a mailing with trunk pick-up information. If you wish to secure the zippers on the trunks or duffle bags, just use some “twist ties”.

BUS AND BUNK ASSIGNMENTS will be e-mailed in early June.

MEDICAL and DENTAL– All Medical Forms and Health Insurance Forms must be into the camp office by June 1. Also, we suggest that your dentist examines your child’s teeth now to prevent trouble during the summer. If orthodontic appliances are worn, have a final check-up before camp in the event of a necessary adjustment. *See information on page 1 for NEW Medication Procedure*

LETTERS HOME – Campers must write home twice a week

PHONE CALLS – Campers may call home at the time you select beginning July 2. *See page 22/23*

BIRTHDAYS – Chen-A-Wanda will **automatically provide a birthday cake** for your camper and his/her birthday will be celebrated in the dining room. *See additional birthday information on page 19*

FOOD PACKAGES – We strictly enforce our policy of **NOT ALLOWING** our campers & staff to **RECEIVE ANY FOOD PACKAGES**. This includes Easy Mac, Cup of Noodles, Water or any kind of drink packets to be added to bottled water. *See package policy on page 8*

ELECTRONIC GUIDELINES – We strictly enforce our policy of any camper found **not following** the rules on small electronics will lose the privilege of having these items in camp and the item(s) will be sent home at the parents’ expense.

- **CAMPERS ARE PERMITTED TO BRING SMALL ELECTRONIC ITEMS.**
such as PSP’s®, iPods® cameras etc.
- **CAMPERS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BRING TV’s, CELL PHONES, iPad® or any device that can access the internet** *See page 9 for a complete list of prohibited items*

ELECTRONIC RULES

• **CAMERAS**

Cameras **may only be used outside of** the bunk on the camp grounds or during trips. Picture taking is **not permitted inside of the bunk** at any time.

• **PSP’s®, IPODS®, SIMILAR ITEMS**

These electronic items **must only be used in the bunk** unless a Head Counselor has given permission to the camper to use it for a specific occasion outside of the bunk.

Please make sure that any of these acceptable items are labeled and that your child knows that he/she **must be extremely careful with these items.**
Chen-A-Wanda ***cannot replace any items that are lost or damaged.***

Directions to the bus pick-up areas will also be posted on the web.

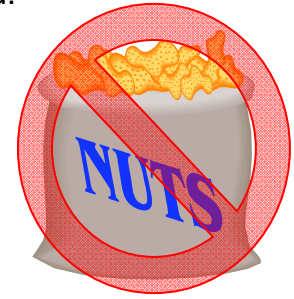
BUS TRIP - CAMPERS SHOULD BRING SANDWICHES (NO NUTS) and DRINKS

CAMPERS ARE PERMITTED TO BRING SPORTS EQUIPMENT ON

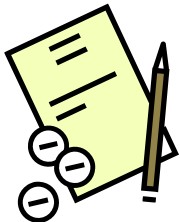
THE BUS. Other last minute items that have not shipped may also be sent, however **NO TRUNKS ARE ALLOWED ON THE BUS.**

Your Camper(s) **MUST** have their **MEDICAL and INSURANCE CARD** forms **COMPLETED and SIGNED** and mailed to CAW by **JUNE 1**



Medications need to be ordered from Camp Meds before coming to camp so the medication is at the camp upon your child's arrival. www.campmeds.com

Your Child CANNOT and WILL NOT be TREATED until your forms have been received by the Health Center STAFF.

Any additional instructions for counselors or **any forms** or **permission slips** that have not been returned as of yet, such as phone call scheduling, personal money requests, and/or birthday pizza party forms should be handed in to a **Director or person in charge** at the bus.

ARRIVAL AT CAMP – When campers arrive at Camp they will find their clothing unpacked, their beds made and activities ready to begin.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I send a Bunk Note (one-way email) to my camper?

Follow the instructions above except, after registering, simply sign in and click on the Bunk Notes button. Enter your camper’s name, select the correct cabin, type your message, and hit the “Send” button.

Why do I have to pay to send Bunk Notes (one-way email)?

Each morning, the Bunk Notes system bundles and sorts the messages for us to print out and distribute to campers. It also protects us from computer viruses and allows us to easily manage these emails. Your payment helps us cover the cost of the system, paper, ink, and labor and, more importantly, frees us to do what we do best – be with your kids! Bunk Note credits cost \$1 each and are purchased in packs of various sizes.

Can other relatives use these services?

Certainly, once you have set up your account, you will be able to invite other people to access these services.

What do I do if I lost my username and password?

You can get it online by going to www.Bunk1.com and clicking on the link “Lost Your Password?” (to the left of the page below the sign in button). You will receive an email with your username and password within a few minutes.

PACKAGE POLICY/LETTER INSTRUCTIONS

PACKAGES – Campers may receive **3 packages** over the summer.

Necessities and Birthday packages do not count as a one of the three packages.

A **flat oversized envelope** with photos, magazines, trading cards, etc. is the same as a **letter** as long as it is **FLAT** and we do not have to open it to check the contents.

CHEN-A-WANDA MAILING LABELS

You will receive **3 mailing labels** for the **3 packages allowed** during the summer.

Please don't put candy into a magazine, a book, a stuffed animal, a tennis ball can, clothing, etc.

We will not give food or anything else on the prohibited list to your camper and we can't guarantee that we can store and to return the item to you. (page 10)

Labels should be on all packages even packages sent directly by a store, priority mail and express mail packages delivered by USPS, UPS, FedEx or any other mailing services.

A PACKAGE DOES NOT NEED A LABEL ...

- **When sending NECESSITIES**

Just alert the office and then send the emergency item **without** the CAW label.

Write your **child's name** & their **bunk letter** in the **lower left hand corner** of the package. **Send** to the attention of: **Nancy Berman** (Office Manager). Be sure to **only include the emergency item** (no extras).

- Cell phones will be allowed on the **HERSHEY Trip ONLY**

**** SUPER AND GC CELL PHONE POLICY**

- Cell phones will be allowed on the **BOSTON Trip ONLY**

**** CIT/ WAITS CELL PHONE POLICY**

- Phones will be **collected**, checked in upon arrival at camp and distributed to the CIT/WAITS on each Day Off and for the BOSTON Trip..
- The cell phones will be collected by the Group Leader after their day off and after the Boston trip.

Phones brought to camp before Visiting Day will be **collected**, checked in upon arrival at camp and then given to your child for the Hershey and the Boston trip.*

Please **label** the **phone** and the **charger** with your child's name.

Remember - You will be unable to get your child's phone on visiting day.

Any cell phone found at camp will be taken away and NOT returned until the last day of camp.

CAMPER PERSONAL ACCOUNTS

Each camper has a **PERSONAL ACCOUNT** set up for them in the main office. This money is used:

- on day trips for purchasing refreshments or souvenirs.
- to purchase batteries, stamps, and sundries in camp.
- to buy bottled water, Snapple, soda, etc. in camp.
(A **Max of \$3.00** per day can be withdrawn by the camper from their account for drink money).



We recommend that campers not keep money in their bunk. If a camper brings cash to camp or receives a check in the mail, he/she should deposit the money in his/her **PERSONAL ACCOUNT in the Main Office**. Please remind him/her that this account is to protect his/her money from getting lost, etc.

For each trip we give your camper the amount of money you indicated on your Personal Account Form for the specific trip (pages 11 - 16).

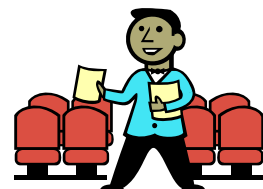

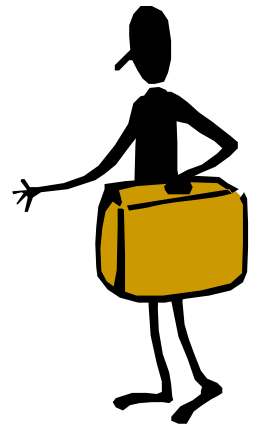
