

#### **NEW MEDICATION PROCEDURE -**

This summer we will be utilizing **Camp Meds** for medication distribution for campers who require medication over the summer.

Camper medical forms as well as information on this new system will be coming to you in the mail.

If your camper requires medication over the summer, **go to** <u>www.campmeds.com</u> for details on how to **register for this service.** 

**Camp Meds** will fill the medications and package them by dosage and then deliver them directly to camp to be distributed to your camper by our nursing staff.

This system is designed for camps to make distribution of meds easier and faster thereby allowing campers to get back to camp activities more guickly.

Please be on the lookout for the mailer with all of the Medical Information.

#### **BEFORE YOU PACK...**

NAME TAPES CAMPER'S FULL NAME must be sewn in or ironed on all clothing.

If marking your child's clothing with a **permanent marker** (ie: Sharpie), please write:

- FIRST and LAST name of your child to make identification clearer if clothing is misplaced.
- DO NOT USE INITIALS as campers may have the same initials as other campers.
- REMEMBER to label shoes, sneakers, sports equipment, hair brushes, and toiletries.

<u>MEDICAL and DENTAL</u>— All Medical Forms and Health Insurance Forms must be into the camp office by June 1. Also, we suggest that your dentist examines your child's teeth now to prevent trouble during the summer. <u>FOOD PACKAGES</u> – We strictly enforce our policy of <u>NOT ALLOWING</u> our campers & staff to <u>RECEIVE ANY FOOD PACKAGES</u>. This includes Easy Mac, Cup of Noodles, Water or any kind of drink packets to be added to bottled water. <u>See package policy on page 8</u>

<u>ELECTRONIC GUIDELINES</u> – We strictly enforce our policy of any camper found <u>not following</u> the rules on small electronics will lose the privilege of having these items in camp and the item(s) will be sent home at the parents' expense.

- CAMPERS ARE <u>PERMITTED</u> TO BRING <u>SMALL ELECTRONIC ITEMS.</u> such as PSP's<sup>®</sup>, iPods<sup>®</sup> cameras etc.
- CAMPERS ARE <u>NOT PERMITTED</u> TO BRING TV's, CELL PHONES, IPad<sup>®</sup> or any device that can access the internet See page 9 for a complete list of prohibited items

#### **ELECTRONIC RULES**

CAMERAS

Cameras <u>may only be used</u> <u>outside</u> of the bunk on the camp grounds or during trips. Picture taking is <u>not permitted</u> <u>inside</u> of the bunk at any time.

PSP's®, iPODS®, SIMILAR ITEMS

These electronic items <u>must only be used in the bunk</u> unless a Head Counselor has given permission to the camper to use it for a specific occasion outside of the bunk.

Please make sure that any of these acceptable items are labeled and that your child knows that he/she <u>must be extremely careful with these items</u>. Chen-A-Wanda *cannot replace any items that are lost or damaged.* 

#### SUMMER 2011 BEGINS SATURDAY, JUNE 25th ...

**CAMPERS TRAVEL TO CAMP** on air-conditioned coach buses equipped with bathrooms.

Directions regarding departure times, and pickup points will be emailed to you.

Directions to the bus pick-up areas will also be posted on the web.

# BUS TRIP - CAMPERS SHOULD BRING SANDWICHES (NO NUTS) and DRINKS

Please remember for the safety of all our campers please do not send any items containing nuts for the camper's lunch.

NO PEANUT BUTTER of any kind.

This includes candy and snacks such as Reese's Peanut Butter Cups, Snickers, etc. Upon arrival at Camp the campers will be served fruit, milk, and cookies.

#### CAMPERS ARE PERMITTED TO BRING SPORTS EQUIPMENT ON

<u>THE BUS</u>. Other last minute items that have not shipped may also be sent, however <u>NO TRUNKS</u> ARE ALLOWED ON THE BUS.

# Your Child CANNOT and <u>WILL NOT</u> be TREATED until your forms have been received by the Health Center STAFF.

Any additional instructions for counselors or any forms or permission slips that have not been returned as of yet, such as phone call scheduling, personal money requests, and/or birthday pizza party forms should be handed in to a **Director or person in charge** at the bus.

**ARRIVAL AT CAMP** — When campers arrive at Camp they will find their clothing unpacked, their beds made and activities ready to begin.

Once again we have partnered with Bunk 1.com. Bunk 1 is a secure, easy to use; summer website service that lets you stay in touch with your camper all summer!

#### **GETTING STARTED TODAY**

To set up a new account and visit our Online Community:

- 2. Click the flashing "Camper Email" button \*
- 3. Click "Register Now"
- 4. Enter your Pre-Approved Registration Code: 115909CN
- 5. Fill out all the required information (Your account comes with 10 Bunk Note Credits)
- 6. Purchase Additional Bunk Note credits (you will need a credit card-Optional)
- 7. Send an email to your camper!
- \* If you cannot find this button, go to <a href="www.CampChenAWanda.bunk1.com">www.CampChenAWanda.bunk1.com</a> instead and continue on to the next step. For your camper's safety, please do not share the Pre-Approved Registration code above.

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### How do I send a Bunk Note (one-way email) to my camper?

Follow the instructions above except, after registering, simply sign in and click on the Bunk Notes button. Enter your camper's name, select the correct cabin, type your message, and hit the "Send" button.

#### Why do I have to pay to send Bunk Notes (one-way email)?

Each morning, the Bunk Notes system bundles and sorts the messages for us to print out and distribute to campers. It also protects us from computer viruses and allows us to easily manage these emails. Your payment helps us cover the cost of the system, paper, ink, and labor and, more importantly, frees us to do what we do best – be with your kids! Bunk Note credits cost \$1 each and are purchased in packs of various sizes.

#### Can other relatives use these services?

Certainly, once you have set up your account, you will be able to invite other people to access these services.

#### What do I do if I lost my username and password?

You can get it online by going to www.Bunk1.com and clicking on the link "Lost Your Password?" (to the left of the page below the sign in button). You will receive an email with your username and password within a few minutes.

#### PACKAGE POLICY/LETTER INSTRUCTIONS

**PACKAGES** – Campers may receive 3 packages over the summer.

Necessities and Birthday packages do not count as a one of the three packages.

A <u>flat oversized envelope</u> with photos, magazines, trading cards, etc. is the same as a **letter** as long as it is <u>FLAT</u> and we do not have to open it to check the contents.

#### **CHEN-A-WANDA MAILING LABELS**

You will receive 3 mailing labels for the 3 packages allowed during the summer.

Please don't put candy into a magazine, a book, a stuffed animal, a tennis ball can, clothing, etc.

We will not give food or anything else on the prohibited list to your camper and we can't guarantee that we can store and to return the item to you. (page 10)

Labels should be on all packages even packages sent directly by a store, priority mail and express mail packages delivered by USPS, UPS, FedEx or any other mailing services.

#### A PACKAGE DOES NOT NEED A LABEL ...

 Just alert the office and then send the emergency item <u>without</u> the CAW label.



- Cell phones will be allowed on the HERSHEY Trip ONLY
- \*\* SUPER AND GC CELL PHONE POLICY
  - Cell phones will be allowed on the BOSTON Trip ONLY
- \*\* CIT/ WAITS CELL PHONE POLICY
- Phones will be **collected**, checked in upon arrival at camp and distributed to the CIT/WAITS on each Day Off and for the BOSTON Trip..
- The cell phones will be collected by the Group Leader after their day off and after the Boston trip.

Phones brought to camp before Visiting Day will be **collected**, checked in upon arrival at camp and then given to your child for the Hershey and the Boston trip.\*

Please **label** the **phone** and the **charger** with your child's name.

Remember - You will be unable to get your child's phone on visiting day.

Any cell phone found at camp will be taken away and NOT returned until the last day of camp.

#### CAMPER PERSONAL ACCOUNTS

Each camper has a <u>PERSONAL ACCOUNT</u> set up for them in the main office. This money is used:



- on day trips for purchasing refreshments or souvenirs.
- to purchase batteries, stamps, and sundries in camp.
- to buy bottled water, Snapple, soda, etc. in camp.
   (A Max of \$3.00 per day can be withdrawn by the camper from their account for drink money).

We recommend that campers <u>not</u> keep money in their bunk. If a camper brings cash to camp or receives a check in the mail, he/she should deposit the money in his/her PERSONAL ACCOUNT in the Main Office. Please remind him/her that this account is to protect his/her money from getting lost, etc.

For each trip we give your camper the amount of money you indicated on your Personal Account Form for the specific trip (pages 11 - 16).

You may check the balance of your child's account at any time by calling the main office, or emailing <a href="mailto:nancy@campcaw.com">nancy@campcaw.com</a>.

This account may be replenished on Visiting Day or by simply mailing a check to us during the summer.

Any money remaining at the end of the summer will be sent home to you by mid September.

Please fill out a separate Personal Account Trip Request form for each camper.
